At time of application, you need to provide:

- 1. The completed application form or fill out application on site.
- 2. Valid ID (Age 18 or older).
- 3. DMV Drivers History Report (proving current and valid driver's license).
- 4. **Photocopy** of your Diploma or GED (We will not make copies).
- 5. Sealed Official Transcript (proving 2 semesters of High School Algebra or 1 semester of College Algebra with a "C" or better).

Other methods to qualify:

<u>Military Veterans:</u> Apply as above (steps 1, 2, & 3 only) and provide a DD-214 with a honorable discharge, 3 years of service or 6 years of reserve, and a date of separation within the last 5 years.

<u>Prior Experience:</u> Apply as above (steps 1, 2, & 3 only) and document work of a minimum of four thousand (4000) hours specifically in the electrical construction industry for a C-10 contractor. You may download the documentation worksheet from our website.

All applicants must be able to work legally in the United States, capable of completing all requirements of the apprenticeship program and performing the work required of an electrical worker.
